540	2006	Rodney Strong Knotty Vines, Sonoma, CA. Bright, fairly opaque ruby, and viscous. It has immediately appealing blueberry, cherry, red rose, Australian black licorice, and crème de menthe notes. Oak comes out with aeration and adds sweet vanillans to the flavor.	\$32	\$8.50
